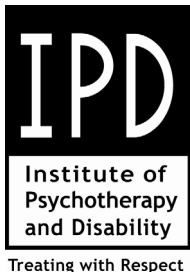


# Working Together



## Psychotherapy and Positive Behaviour Support

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) is an approach that is achieving widespread adoption. Guidance from the Department of Health and NICE recommends the use of PBS when working with people with learning disabilities whose behaviour can be challenging. But what is the role of Psychotherapy within the PBS framework?
